LEVEL 1**PART 5 – SPEAKING**

The oral part is divided into three steps: a guided interview, a monologue and a role-play. The whole paper lasts about 15 minutes, involving a pair of candidates and two examiners. The speaking component contributes 20% of the mark of the whole test.

A) GUIDED INTERVIEW

This takes about 3-4 minutes. In this part, each candidate interacts with the interlocutor, using the language normally associated with meeting people for the first time, giving factual information of a personal kind, for example name, place of origin, occupation/studies, family, etc. Candidates are also expected to be able to talk about their daily life, interests, likes, hobbies, free time activities, etc.


Example questions:

- What's your full name?
- How do you spell your last name?
- Tell me about your family. Are you married? Do you have any children/brothers and sisters?
How old are they? Where do they live? What do they do?
- Where are you from? What's your home town? Tell me about your home town.
- Describe your house/flat. Talk about your area.
- What do you do? Do you like your job? Why (not)?
- Describe your daily routine on weekdays.
- Do you live near your place of work/school?
- What do you do in your free time? etc.


B) MONOLOGUE

Each candidate is given a card with a topic to talk about. Each card also includes pictures that illustrate the topic while triggering ideas. The aim is to evaluate the ability to talk freely about a given familiar topic. The time given to each candidate is approximately 3-4 minutes.
